#### **The Need**

7% of young people in Weld County fail to graduate from high school on time.<sup>2</sup>

#### **What We Do**

We strive to have all of our Club members graduate from high school ready for college, trade school, military or employment.

#### **Our Impact**

Among our teen-aged Club members, 99% expect to graduate from high school, and

**79%** expect to complete some kind of post-secondary education.

#### The Need

24% of high-school youth in United States were involved in a physical fight in the past year.<sup>3</sup>

#### **What We Do**

We want to empower our youth to be engaged citizens: involved in the community, model strong character and register to vote.

#### **Our Impact**

62% of Club teen members volunteer in their community at least once per year, while 48% volunteer in their community at leastonce per month.





#### **The Need**

22% of young people ages 5-14 in Colorado are overweight or obese.4

#### **What We Do**

Engage members in adopting a healthy diet, practice healthy lifestyle choices and make a lifelong commitment to fitness.

#### **Our Impact**

**82%** of Club members ages 9 and older report getting at least an hour of physical activity on five or more days per week.
