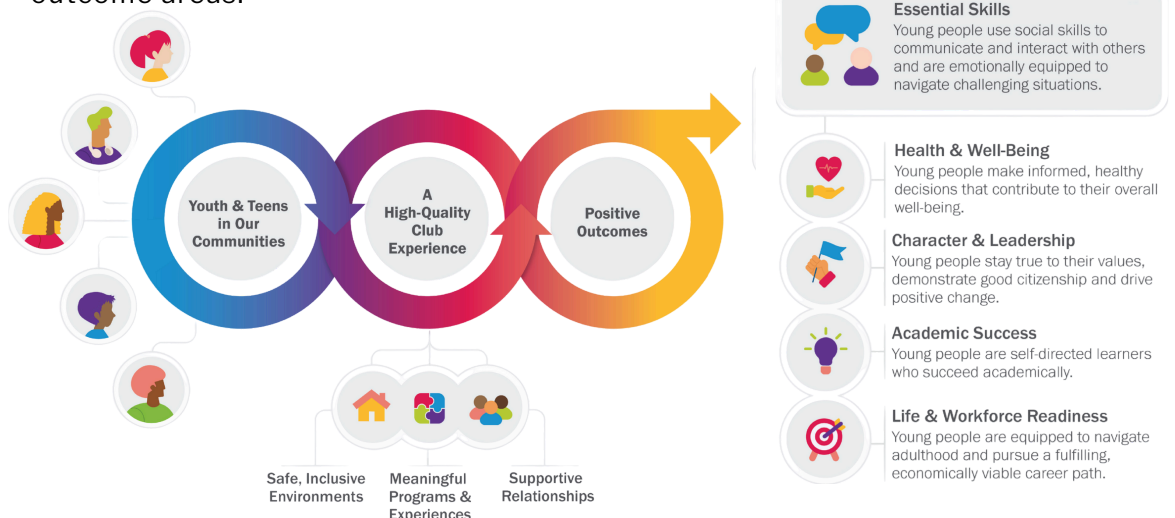

## Bringing Our Mission to Life

At the heart of our mission is delivering a world-class Club Experience so that success and reaching their potential is within reach for every young person who walks through our doors. Each day, we help members build the skills and confidence needed to graduate from high school, demonstrate leadership and good character, live healthy lifestyles, and prepare for life and career opportunities. Guided by our proven Formula for Impact, we create pathways to opportunity that might otherwise remain closed, regardless of zip code or circumstance. Through high-quality programs, supportive mentors, and inclusive environments, we empower young people to thrive as leaders and engaged citizens.

## Formula for Impact

Our five core program areas work together to help members become their best selves. When youth experience safe, welcoming spaces paired with meaningful programs and trusted staff relationships, the results are clear across our four key outcome areas.



## Momentum That Opens More Doors

Since opening our first Clubhouse in 1964, Boys & Girls Clubs of Weld County has grown from a single location into six Clubhouses across Weld and Morgan counties, now serving nearly 400 youth each day. The past two years have marked a period of exciting growth, including the opening of our Fort Morgan Clubhouse in June 2023 and the launch of our new Teen Center in May 2024. Together, these expansions welcomed nearly 150 additional youth over the summer and more than 100 new members during the school year. Building on this momentum, we introduced Future Ready, a bold strategic vision focused on being better, bigger, and bolder for the youth we serve. This vision prioritizes expanded access to high-quality programs in Health & Well-Being, Character & Leadership, Academic Success, and Life & Workforce Readiness. Community support is essential to sustaining this growth and ensuring every young person has access to opportunities that help them learn, lead, and thrive.

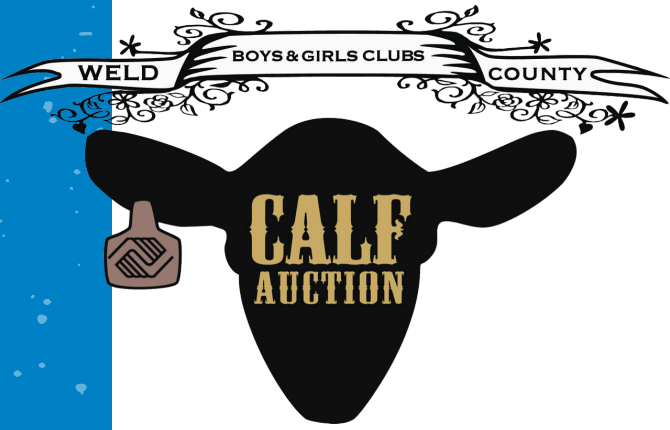


